



The aim of the AEL Course is to raise leaders (IMEP:


Internationally-Minded

Concentrating specifically on Eastern Asia, we are attempting

to raise (1) Education researchers who are able to accurately analyze current problems in education, (2) Teacher leaders who are able to recognize educational problems and carry out their responsibilities for education in practice, (3) Education administrators who are able to incorporate educational reforms from all around the world in their perspective when making new policies. Registered students for the course will take approximately 15-day intensive courses during their long vacations at partner universities as learning sites.



The College of Education was established on August 1, 2002, with the mission of nurturing the nation's educators, academic leaders and researchers, at the same time providing them opportunities to develop into professionals in all aspect of the education industry, thus playing an important role in uplifting the professional standards of academia throughout Taiwan.
